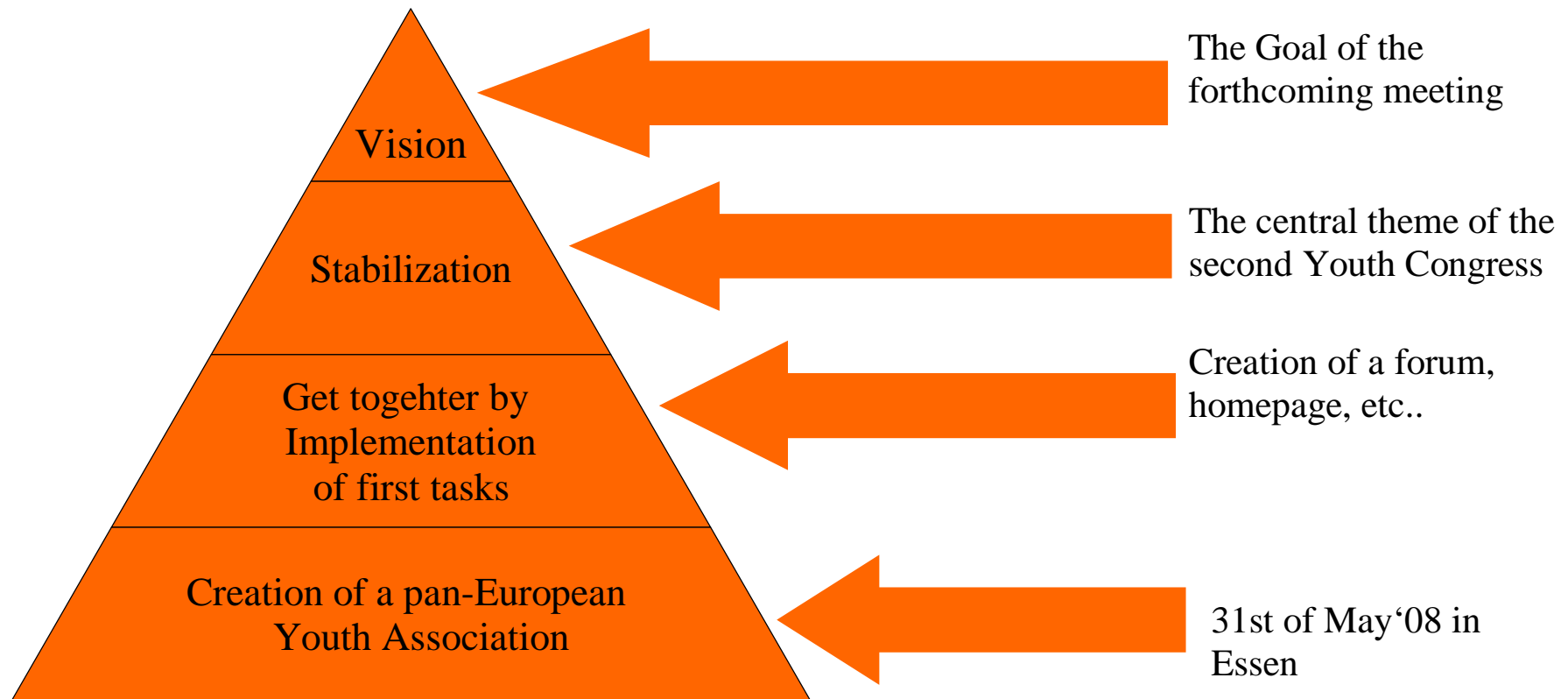

Suggested solutions:

- ü Creation of an organizational structure
- ü Legalization of association (EHSYA)
- ü Creation of a constitution respectively statute
- ü Formation and Implementation of a common vision
- ü Formation of specific teams
- ü Discussion on further projects and goals

Organizational structure



§ For each successful and stable organization – also for charity proposals - it is more than essential to have a functioning organizational structure.

§ Due to the fact that EHSYA is a project of the Central Council, the new organization needs to affiliate itself to the Central Council. The level of the autonomy should be clarified separately in the constitution / statutes of EHSYA.

§ To ensure a certain level of this autonomy, EHSYA should be represented and managed by a executive board .

§ In addition to the Board of executive, EHSYS should have a board of representative to ensure a minimum level of internal control, coordination and flow of communication.

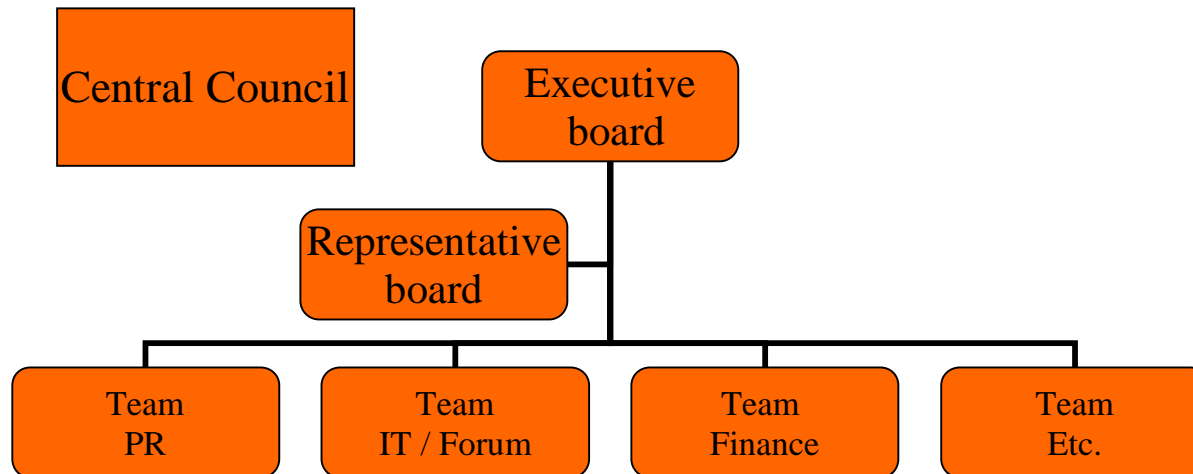
§ Furthermore, specific teams should be created, who work autonomous on specific topics and it is their responsibility to present their progress to the entire association.
